**A. SPECIAL MEETING**

**1. Call to Order- Mayor, Bruce Densley**

Mayor Densley reported that the town had 4 to 5 times the turn out of other communities.

**2. Declaration of Conflict of Interest.**

Danyale Blackmore stated she had a conflict because she was a candidate.

**3. Review and Certification of 2015 General Election Results.**

Monica Bowcutt, Town Clerk, stated that she had been in contact with various government agencies about the election results. She reported:

- 8 outstanding ballots
- 5 provisional and 3 absentee

Of the absentee, two had been returned and would be counted and considered residents. One had not been received and would not be counted. Of the provisional, two were not registered in Utah, therefore, would not be counted. One provisional was registered in the County and would be counted. In total, 5 votes would be counted during the meeting. She also reported that if there was a tie, the candidate had 7 days to request a recount. It there

was still a tie, straws would be drawn to determine the winner.

Monica Bowcutt, opened the ballots, with Mayor Densley affirming the votes. They were as follows:

Danyale Blackmore	1	Total: 127+1=128
Lyman Everett	3	Total: 117+3=120
Dan Snyder	3	Total: 126+3=129
Matt Spendlove	1	Total: 138+1=139

Matt Spendlove and Dan Snyder won.

***Jean Krause moved to accept the votes as presented. Bruce Densley gave the second. Roll call vote: Bill Adams-No; Danyale Blackmore-No, Jean Krause-Aye, Jay Lee-abstain; and Mayor Bruce Densley-Aye. The motion failed 2-2 with 1 abstain.***

Town Attorney Heath Snow stated that the town could vote to request a recount.

***Bill Adams moved to withhold approval until a recount could be held, after which another canvass would be held. Danyale Blackmore gave the second.***

The Council discussed the details of a recount. The date was set for Monday, November 16, 2015 at 6:00 pm. There will be a canvass following.

***Roll call vote: Bill Adams-Aye; Danyale Blackmore-Aye, Jean Krause-No, Jay Lee-Aye; and Mayor Bruce Densley-Aye. The motion passed 4-1.***
