**A. SPECIAL MEETING: Action Items**

**1. Call to Order- Mayor, Bruce Densley**

**2. Declaration of Conflict of Interest.**

**3. 2015 General Election Vote Recount**

The poll workers and Monica Bowcutt began the recount. They counted the ballots into groups of 25. Each group was read into the record as a group of 25. It was clarified that 336 voters were registered with the County. The recount was completed in this manner, with one group of 25 being counted three times.
